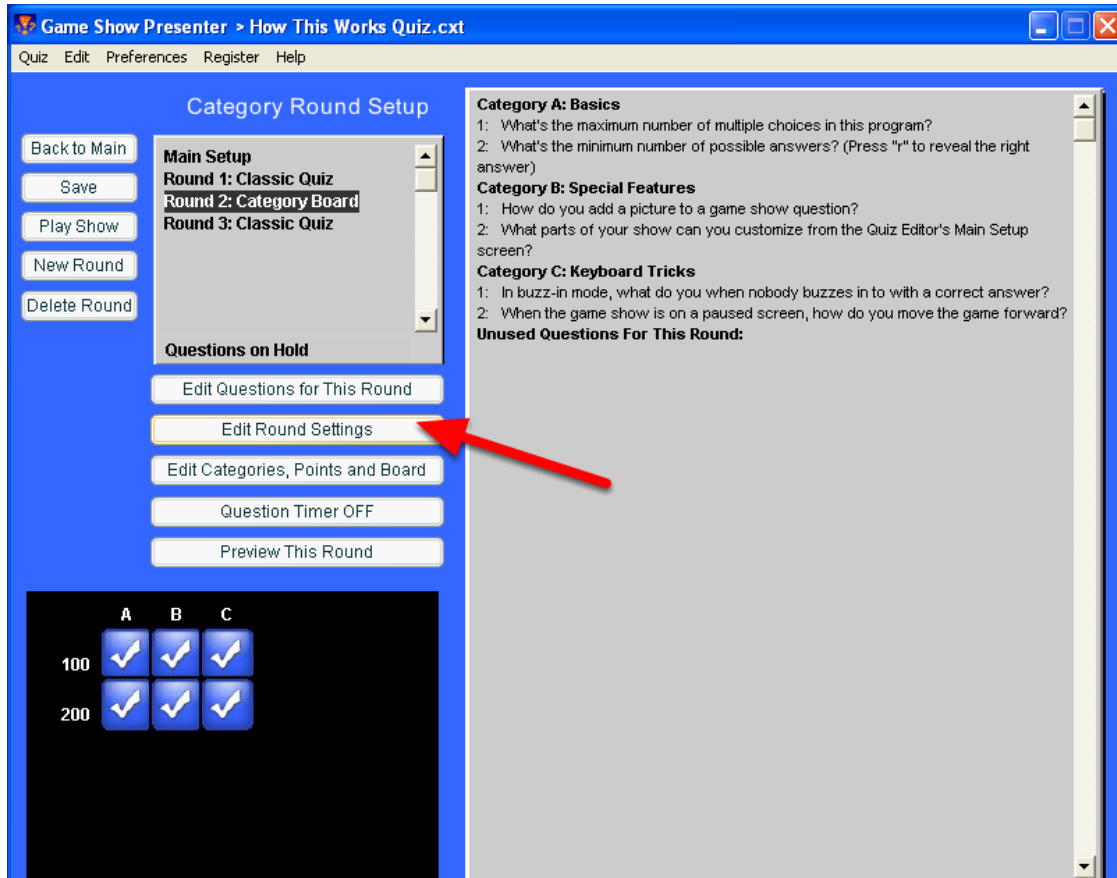


How to Move Rounds in your Quiz File

If your quiz file has more than one round, sometimes you may want to change the order of those rounds. Here's how to do that in the **Game Show Presenter PLUS Edition**:

Go to the Round you want to move and click the button "Edit Round Settings". In this shot, we've gone to Round 2 and our goal is to move this round to be the first round.



Use the round number drop menu to select the new round number for this round.

Round Settings

This round is: Round 2 (dropdown menu open showing Round 1, Round 2, Round 3)

NOTE: Maximum is 12 rounds.

Game type for round: (dropdown menu)

If you want this round to have a special title, type it below: (text input)

Reset scores to 0 for round

Change players (Add player details now button)

At the END of this round, what next? (Choose from menu below)

Continue show automatically (dropdown menu)

Cancel OK

When the "Round Settings" window opens, the first control is a drop down menu that show the current round number of this round. To move this round to make it Round 1, just use the drop down menu to select "Round 1". Then click OK.

That's it! Round 2 has become Round 1. Slick **SAVE** to finish.

When you close the Round Settings window, you'll see in the menu listing of the rounds that the change has been made. Just click the **SAVE** button to lock it in. Now the former round 2 is round 1 (and round 1 has automatically moved to round 2).
